Call for Manuscripts

Journal of Interdisciplinary Studies in Education, a peer-reviewed publication, is currently accepting manuscripts for forthcoming volumes. This is a professional journal that publishes interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary theoretical and empirically-based research articles, and book reviews related to all aspects of teaching and learning at all levels. The journal audience includes students, faculty, administrators, all engaged in research and practice in education.

Published bi-annually in print and online versions, the journal encourages the submission of original manuscripts from around the world, and from a wide range of academic fields, including comparative education, international education, student affairs, and culture studies in education.

Submission Requirements

- Maximum length of articles is *15 double-spaced pages* in 12-point type, Times New Roman, standard margins (1" on all sides).
- Manuscripts *must* be prepared according to the guidelines in the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association*, Sixth Edition.
- Include an abstract of 120 words or less.
- Do *not* use footnotes.
- Electronic submissions only.

Submission Process

Please submit *two (2) copies* of the manuscript as email attachments in MS Word or rich text format:

- One complete copy with a title page that includes the names (in the order in which they should appear), mailing addresses, telephones, faxes, and emails of all authors; and
- One "masked" copy without author name(s), institution(s), or contact information.
